




















HARRY SKRUCH'S THUNDERBIRD OIL REPORT

Harry Skruch sent an oil sample from his Thunderbird to Blackstone Laboratories to be analyzed. Below is a copy of the report he received. The company said that the length of time the engine runs and uses the oil is more important to degradation than time the oil is resting in the engine. Good news for us old car lovers who put limited miles on our vehicles. Read the report below. Contact Harry for info if you would an oil analysis for your bird.

HARRY: It's not a big deal that the oil was in place for two years. For modern engines, the amount of use oil sees is much more important than calendar time. Your T-Bird has another great set of results to its name. Metals are holding steady even after a longer oil run, with just copper (from brass/bronze) inching up a little. We'll keep an eye on that, but not out of any serious concern as 6 ppm isn't enough to show an issue. It's just everything else is so stable that even a minor change stands out. The TBN is strong at 5.9. Try up to 5,000 miles if you'd like.
