MATC is Now A VTCI Chapter

You may have noticed that there is a new, additional logo in the header for this newsletter. MATC is now officially a chapter of the Vintage Thunderbird Club International (VTCI). Your officers and Board of Directors have been working on this for a long time. VTCI is the oldest, longest running club representing all years and vintages of Thunderbirds. It was originally established to support owners of 1958-60 Thunderbirds and was called the "Squarebird Society" in reference to the nickname designated to the first generation of 4 seat TBirds. As interest in later versions of TBirds developed collectible and special interest status they were included as well. MATC was formerly the Mid-Atlantic Chapter of the Vintage Thunderbird Club of America (VTCA) which was the forerunner of VTCI. With the establishment of the International Thunderbird Club (ITC) 30 years ago, the officers of the Mid-Atlantic Chapter of VTCI decided to become associated with ITC because of disagreements regarding the management of VTCI at the time. VTCI offers lots of benefits to Thunderbird owners. These include an excellent bi-monthly publication, the Thunderbird Scoop, an annual convention with a judged car show, a Facebook page, technical assistance for all year Thunderbirds, and much more. Who's Who In MATC

Featured Member(s): Al & Lois Herman By Al Herman





Lois and I have been married for 52 years and have two sons and two grandsons. When we got married, I had a 1968 Shelby Mustang GT350 convertible. I purchased it in 1969 and was its original owner. After the gas shortage of the early 1970s I sold it to buy a more fuel-efficient, family-oriented Toyota station wagon. Too bad I couldn't have been able to keep it, as their prices have soared after Carroll Shelby's death and the limited number of Shelby convertibles produced.

My love for the '56 T'Bird happened when it came out and I was 9 years old; the port hole hard top, continental tire and a pretty powerful V-8 (remember my 68 Shelby fit this bill). I found this car in Greensboro PA (just east of Pittsburgh) and is its 4th owner. The second owner had bought it from a California resident without an engine or transmission. Being too big of a project he sold it to the third owner, who had installed a Ford 302 V8 and a C4 automatic and did a mediocre restoration of the car. The worst thing was its very poor Peacock Blue paint job. After investigating the car, I found out that it had 3.73 gears and surmised that the original Y-block and transmission were trashed from racing it.

Since we purchased this car, I have done several mechanical upgrades-disc brakes, higher efficient water pump, bigger aluminum radiator, AOD automatic transmission with overdrive. Cosmetically I had the car's paint stripped, the body reworked and a good Peacock Blue paint job. While this was being done, I stripped out the interior and added two different layers of insulation on the floor boards. There are still a few issues with my Bird I'd like to address, but this high rate of inflation has held us back some.

My partiality to Ford happened because my parents had always bought Dodges from a close friend's dealership until we got a real lemon in 1958. They bought a '55 Fairlane which I became the primary driver. It had a 272 Y-block and 3 on the tree standard transmission. This was my braking in as a shade tree mechanic. The '55 had 54k miles on it when purchased and 180k miles when they sold it. The person who bought it put another 100k on it before it was scrapped. My first real car was a 66 Mustang my parents had bought me when I went to college (I commuted due to finances) which I sold to buy the Shelby.

We are members of PCTC (our first car club) and CTCI. Joe Zentgraf stopped in a gas station when I was filling up the 56 Bird and introduced himself. Joe took me to a MATC meeting at Skip Panowitz's house where I proceeded to join MATC.

I was doing car shows and parades, both of which I have cut back. I still try to do DC's St. Patrick's & Cherry Blossom and Silver Spring's parades. From the above picture you can see fringe benefits may be involved (but Lois chaperones me to certain parades as you can see her with her matching turquoise earmuffs). I still enjoy going to Rockville's car show as it has such a wide variety of cars.
