JACK SAFETY

One of the many benefits I received from spending over 35 years working at BGE was the importance of working safely. Providing a safe working environment, providing extensive safe work practice training and providing the finest tools and personal protective equipment was and still is paramount there. For most of us, this thought carried over to our home life, too. I never do crazy things I did when I was younger, knew everything and was invincible. So this thought carries over to the garage when I'm working on my Thunderbird or other vehicles. If we're not careful while working on our cars, a simple 5 minute job can quickly turn into an injury or worse, a tragedy.

I was recently reminded of this. My '63 Tbird had developed a slight rumble in the right rear wheel. Suspecting a bearing, I jacked up the car and gave the wheel a spin. I didn't hear or feel anything unusual but did notice a slight dimple in the sidewall. The tires are new (another safety story I'll tell next time) and the flaw didn't appear serious. Regardless, I decided to rotate the tire to the front and listen for any change. I was using my trusty, 40 year old, light duty floor jack. After placing the rear of the car on a jack stand and removing the tire, I moved my jack to the front, jacked up the car and removed the front tire. Then, while placing the rear tire on the front hub, I found that the car was about ½ inch too low. Strange. I gave my jack a couple pumps raising the car slightly and tried again to no avail. The wheel was again, slightly too low. Seems the jack was leaking internally and unable to hold the car. I had a helper available so I asked him to start pumping the jack thinking he could raise the car long enough for me to get the wheel on. We never made it. Even while vigorously pumping the jack, the car quickly sank to the floor right down to the frame.

Lesson # 1 – NEVER, EVER work underneath a car supported only by a hydraulic jack, or any jack for that matter without a positive mechanical safety support! I was never in danger here because I never got under the car. Of all the stupid and unsafe acts I've committed in my life, I don't think I've ever broken this rule. NEVER get under a car supported by a jack except to properly place a sturdy stand for positive support!

Lesson # 2 – The only method I had to get the car off the ground was to use a low profile scissor jack. Each of my 3 collector cars has one. Two out of three didn't work. The crank handles were wrong and the jacks were too old and crudded up to be of any avail should I have needed them out on the road. I also found one of the spare tires was flat. Nothing particularly dangerous here, but the scolding you'll endure from your loved one for being so absent minded and possibly having to forfeit a nice drive in the countryside isn't worth it. Keep those spare tires and tools you carry in good shape.

We're in this hobby because we enjoy working on and driving Thunderbirds (and other marks) and socializing with our friends at meets, tours and in our garages. Most of us are now at an age where we don't bounce back as quickly as we used to after an illness or injury. So friends, think twice before attempting to do something in a less than a perfectly safe manner. Your friends and family want to see you at the next event!

Here's a story. I'm working on more. Unfortunately....My bird is down for the count. The power steering box went up....big time. Fortunately right in the driveway...dumped fluid all over the place. Bill Clark told me to contact Jim Wulf the technical advisor for the bullet birds. What a nice guy! Full of information and lots of friendly advice. Hopefully today I'll have it out of the car (I'm working slowly). I'm replacing the pump and lines also....slowly. Take care.

The Pottsville station, also known as Union Station Intermodal Transit Center, is a transit station in Pottsville, Pennsylvania. Originally a Reading Railroad station, it currently houses bus service, the Schuylkill County Visitors Bureau, and occasional train service.

The station was originally built by the Reading Railroad, and later served the SEPTA diesel service line but was shut down in 1981, when SEPTA cancelled the diesel service. After several years of effort, the county refurbished the building to serve the Schuylkill Transportation System and the visitors bureau. In 2013, the Reading Blue Mountain and Northern Railroad began hosting further recreational train trips to Philadelphia.

Pioneer Tunnel Coal Mine

Pioneer Tunnel is a horizontal drift mine. Its level tunnel runs 1800 feet straight into the side of the Mahanoy Mountain. You make the trip in comfort, riding in open mine cars pulled by a battery-operated mine motor. The temperature inside the mine averages 52 degrees, so a sweater or jacket is recommended. Deep inside the mine, you will exit from your car and follow your miner-guide as you are given an explanation of how coal is mined. There are storyboards inside the mine depicting the mining operation. Your guide will point out the numerous coal seams and describe various configurations of passageways, some cut from solid rock in order to reach the coal.
